
LCA Steps to Admission

NEW STUDENTS

1. **Submit application, Request for Records, and Teacher/Principal recommendation** along with a **\$125.00 Registration/Testing Fee**(non-refundable) to the school office.
2. Life Christian Academy will administer **Entrance Tests** specific to our curriculum to all applicants. Test dates are scheduled as needed. Testing is done at LCA to determine whether we are able to provide the academic program that your child needs. LCA does not have the staff, equipment, or materials to adequately meet the needs of students with significant learning or behavioral disabilities. Testing results are viewed by a committee of faculty and administration, and grade level placement is at the discretion of LCA.
3. **Pastor Referral Letter** must be on file before students are accepted.
4. **Decision Letters** will be sent, or phone calls made, after testing is complete and previous school records and recommendations are on file. Waiting List letters will be sent if the student is accepted, but an opening is not currently available. We do not give out information regarding placement in the waiting pool. Please be assured that we will notify you as soon as an opening occurs for your child. Preferential consideration is given to siblings of currently enrolled students, as well as members of LCCI.
5. **Textbook Fees are due July 1st.**
6. **Tuition is payable beginning August 1st.** Tuition can be paid in 10 monthly payments or for the full year, at a discount on July 1st.
7. **Uniform** pants can be purchased through local stores. Uniform shirts are only available through LCA. Order forms may be obtained at the school office.
8. **Certificate of Immunization and Birth Certificate.** Must be on file in the school office before the first day of school. No student will be allowed to begin school without these on file.

Tuition must be paid by the 10th of the month. A \$35 late fee will be assessed to each account after the 10th. (If pre-approved, returning student's parents may make tuition payments on 11 or 12 month plans.)

An Oasis

Hope spring forth like an oasis in the desert at Life Christian Academy at Palmyra. The school is located in what was formerly the Palmyra Elementary School operated by the Dougherty County School System, hence the “Palmyra” retained in the name. Word studies indicate that a “palmyra” is somewhat similar to an oasis, where water comes back to the surface in a dry, desert climate. Life Christian Academy at Palmyra was founded in order to give Christian children hope and a refuge from a system that does not allow God in the classroom, and becomes more anti-Christian each year.

Life Christian Academy, starting its tenth year, began as a small church school, but has grown at a record pace each year of its existence. The majority of its students do not attend the founding church (Life Christian Center International) but come from different churches and denominations in Albany, Lee County, Worth County, Mitchell County and Terrell County. The growth of the school is attributed to the fact that it was founded as a school for Christian children. Students are not accepted at LCA unless they have a regularly attended Christian church home. Christian values taught at the student’s home church are reinforced at school through daily devotions, pledges to the flag, and Bible classes.

LCA is fully accredited by Georgia accrediting Commission (GAC) and employs only teachers that meet GAC standards. Using A Beka and Bob Jones University curricula, LCA offers classes in Bible, mathematics, reading, vocabulary, spelling, social studies, science, literature, and Spanish for Pre-K (age 4) through 12th Grade. Extracurricular activities include drama, dance, cheerleading, volleyball, basketball, soccer as well as other sports.

Life Christian Academy is also an approved site for the PSAT, administered to high school students in preparation for the SAT. Students from all area schools may take the PSAT by registering with LCA.

The school has experienced steady growth for the past nine years. Each year additional activities are added for the students. The school has adopted a program of continuing faculty improvement even though the school employs an outstanding group of teachers. As the school enters its tenth year of existence it is poised to become a leader in Christian education.

FACT SHEET

History:

Life Christian Academy at Palmyra was founded in 2001 as a ministry of Life Christian Center International. In 2002 the school occupied the building which was formerly Palmyra Elementary School and the words "at Palmyra" were added to our name. The school is fully accredited by Georgia Accrediting Commission.

Location:

Our school is located one block west of Slappey Blvd. at 1225 W. Fourth Avenue, Albany, Georgia

Facilities:

Our campus consist of approximately 27,000 sq. ft. of floor space on approximately 4 acres. It includes a playground, lunchroom and auditorium.

Student Profile:

LCA is clearly an area school, with students from at least six surrounding counties attending. Less than one-half of the students are represented by families who are members of LCCI. The balance represent families from many different denominations and churches in the area. LCA challenges students academically while supporting values consistent with Christianity. LCA graduates have gone on to success at Darton College, Valdosta State and other colleges and tech schools studying a variety of disciplines.

Student/Teacher Ratio:

LCA is committed to successfully guiding our students through their spiritual and academic experiences. Part of our commitment is maintaining a low student/teacher ratio. Currently our average classroom size is 16.

Teachers:

The life-blood of our ministry to the students is our teaching staff. LCA believes that teaching is a calling and not a learned skill. Some of our staff hold Georgia Teaching Certificates and all meet the standards required for accreditation by Georgia Accrediting Commission.

Curriculum:

Currently LCA uses a combination of Bob Jones University and A Beka curriculum in the school. If any curriculum changes should occur, another Christian curriculum would be chosen. All subjects taught at LCA are from a Christian perspective with a Biblical worldview.

Uniforms:

A uniform requirement with ample choices enables each student to better focus on his or her individual achievement.

Discipline:

At Life Christian Academy, we believe in and maintain orderliness and structure in the classroom and in the hallways. We strive to provide clear guidelines to the students in a loving environment as well as keep parents informed on all matters of correction.
